

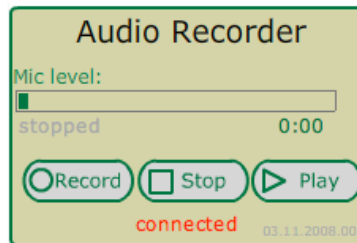

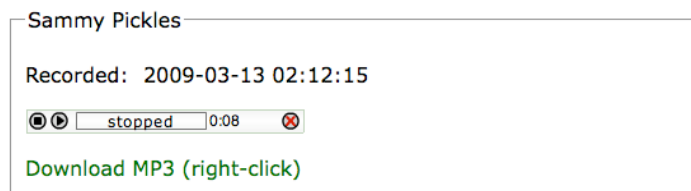
What if adding speaking work to your language class was as easy as clicking a “Record” button on a web page?



The Flash plugin plus special server software make recording as easy for students as browsing a website.


What kinds of speaking work could you add to your language class?

1. Directed speaking assignments




Teachers put an *Audio Dropbox* into their web page. From the web page, students record themselves. Audio files are automatically deposited into the teacher’s dropbox, from which teachers can listen to, download, and delete the files.

2. Prompted oral responses

Record questions for your students to answer asynchronously.



Using *Conversations*, teachers create prompts, which are presented to students in sequence, as in an interview situation. The program presents the prompts and begins recording students' responses automatically.
